**Inside Callaway Resort and Gardens**

**Piedmont Dining Room at the Lodge:**

Breakfast. Lunch. Dinner. No matter what meal it is, The Piedmont Dining Room has something delicious in store for you. Discover eclectic Southern fare, featuring guest favorites like Crispy Brussels Sprouts, Pecan Crusted Salmon, Roasted Prime Rib, and savory Southern Shrimp and Grits.

*RMK Comment: Known for its buffets on Friday and Saturday nights, a good menu with good food. The dining room itself has been recently totally remodeled and looks nice. We seldom eat there, not because we don't like it, but because we like Cason's Tap Room next door better. It is more intimate and fun.*

**Cason's Tap Room inside the Lodge:**

Cason's Tap Room is a tribute to Callaway Gardens' founder, the late Cason J. Callaway's pioneering spirit and fortitude. This Pine Mountain restaurant and bar offers handcrafted cocktails, modern Southern cuisine, and the latest craft beers on tap in a setting that would make our founder proud to entertain colleagues, friends and family alike.

Our Pine Mountain restaurant menu features entrees, soups, salads, sandwiches, small bites, desserts, with some recipes derived from the Callaway family cookbook and all with a modern twist on southern comfort food. Georgia produced items such as cheeses from Elberton Farms and Sweet Grass Dairy, and cured meats from The Spotted Trotter Farm are highlighted. The bar hosts a variety of chef inspired cocktails meticulously crafted down to the last detail, even pairing appropriate ice and glassware. Cason's features some of Georgia's best craft breweries, as well as a signature draft beer, "Cason's Craft." The wine list offers over twenty wines by the glass including Callaway Vineyards.

*RMK Comment: This is our go-to place inside Callaway Gardens. Much like Iron Horse Grill just outside the Gardens it has a bit of a neighbor bar feel, but offers seating at the bar, at tables inside the bar and outside seating, which is nice when the weather is good.*

**Champions Grill at Callaway Resort and Gardens:**

Located at the golf clubhouse not far from the Lodge, looking out over the golf course in all directions, Champions offers indoor and outdoor dining. The food is primary appetizers, burgers, hot dogs, sandwiches, chicken fingers, and salads.

An online menu is not available, but a general link is shown below. Not a wide menu, but in good weather a great view of the golf course and surrounding areas.

Start your day with a hearty plate of sausage and grits or eggs benedict. Savor some Southern fried chicken for lunch or dinner, and wash it down with a mason jar of classic sweet tea. Whatever your fancy, your taste buds are sure to be pleased at this Callaway restaurant.

*RMK Comment: This is technically part of the Gardens, although you have to go out onto Highway 27 to get to it. It is worth going to just for the feel of the place and the view. A good mountain/valley view for those of us not living in North Georgia.*
